Even small improvements can mean huge results later on in a game. People often ask how I managed to play against Bobby Fischer. Though we played a few games, we spent most of the time dissecting the details of strategies, and developing innovative tactics that would help us crush opponents in tournaments."



By detailing her amazing rise in the chess world, overcoming political, gender, religious, and intellectual obstacles along the way, Susan guides an audience to realize how they, too, can strive to greater heights. She encourages listeners to reconsider how they have been working in the past.
